CALLING ALL ENGLE-REDS

NOVEMBER 14, 1952

At a state-wide meeting held in New Jersey late in 1950, ELIZABETH GURLEY FLYNN, a national leader of the Communist Party, "instructed all comrades to join church, fraternal, civic, veteran, and educational groups." She placed particular emphasis upon the PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATIONS which, according to an article in the ELK'S MAGAZINE, July 1951, "are focal points of Communist activity and have been for many years." The same article further pointed out that joining and working in the P.T.A.'s "is one of the main points on the agenda of the Communist Party."

It Can Happen Here!

Once the Communists, or their fronters, gain control of a P.T.A. or a school board, they use it as a "transmission belt" for Communist propaganda and action. From this vantage point, they are then in a position to indoctrinate subtly and insidiously large segments of our school children. The Communists can gain this control with a minimum of effort because the average citizen is willing to "let George do it." It is said that to gain admission into certain P.T.A. meetings, you have to say, "Joe sent me."

Communist fractions can be counted on to undermine the leadership of any organization they infiltrate. The subverters lay careful plans to lead programs ostensibly to improve our schools, our hospitals, housing conditions, etc. They use these programs to enlist the support of many sincere people who fail to realize that they are being taken for a ride on a RED ROLLER COASTER.

Such fine sounding titles as "Better Schools Committee" are used by the REDS to mask their real objectives. Over in the Bronx they have a "Better Schools Committee" which was headed by one A. Newman. This gink was ousted from his teaching job because of alleged RED activities. He was a member of the "Communist dominated" Teacher's Union. Dr. Whalen, N. Y. Schools Assistant Superintendent, indicating his awareness of the purposes for which these committees are frequently used, stated that "he didn't have a very high opinion about the Better Schools Committee . . ." Amen!

Announcements in our local papers tell us that Englewood is to have its own "Better Schools Committee" sponsored by the Womán's Club. They have already succeeded in enlisting in a united front the support of many organizations of which some are of unquestioned responsibility. However, we must not lose sight of the fact that, according to the ELK'S MAGAZINE article, "Communists are working in the Republican and Democratic Parties, in church groups of all denominations, in Women's Clubs, and in fraternal, civic and veterans' organizations."

Stalin, Inc.

STALIN himself has just recently ordered Communists in all countries to recreate the "United Fronts" of the 1930's and he promised them his full support. Therefore, one can naturally expect to find, masked and hiding behind the facade of respectability of reputable organizations, the old familiar RED faces of STALIN'S stooges and STALIN'S stooges' stooges. It would seem almost unnecessary for STALIN to issue these orders insofar as Englewood is concerned. This community's reputation as a focal point of Communist-front activity is nationally known. In fact, Englewood was referred to as a "Hot-bed of Communist activity" in one of New Jersey's leading daily newspapers.

Guilt by Association?

Englewood has played host to a virtual parade of persons whose names have been identified with the RED CONSPIRACY in the records of the HOUSE COMMITTEE ON UN-AMERICAN ACTIVITIES. Just a few among them have been: LOUIS DOLIVET, WILLSAM S. GAILMOR, DR. HARRY WARD, FREDA KIRCHWEY, MARY McLEOD BETHUNE, GERHART EISLER, REV. JAMES A. MITCHELL, WILLIAM L. SHIRER, and MARGARET BOURKE-WHITE. The latter two, at least, were brought to Englewood to speak before the WOMAN'S CLUB, sponsors of this new "UNITED FRONT."

MARGARET BOURKE-WHITE'S name appears no less than 15 times in official Government un-American Activities Reports. Angela Calomiris, former F.B.I. operative, in her book, "Red Masquerade," revealed that Miss White was a director of the Infamous "PHOTO LEAGUE," cited by the Attorney General as "a subversive Communist-front." Only the other day a lecture series was "cancelled" by Marshall College, Huntington, West Virginia, following an American Legion protest. Three of the scheduled speakers were alleged to have Communist-front affiliations. One of the three was, "LIFE MAGAZINES' MARGARET BOURKE-WHITE."

Little Red Riding Hoods?

Who in the Englewood Woman's Club was responsible for inviting Miss White as a speaker? Was it the same person or persons who are behind the invitation to Roy E. Larsen who, like Miss White, is connected with Henry Luce's TIME-LIFE publications. These magazines rank high among the top smear sheets in this country. TIME magazine has viciously attacked anti-Communists, and smeared them in their efforts to rid our country of the Communist menace. It throws pebbles at Communism generally—at times—but then "parallels the (COMMUNIST) Daily Worker's smear attack upon individuals who start to dig out the dangerous secret Communists." Thus, wittingly or otherwise, TIME gives aid to the RED CONSPIRATORS.

The October 9, 1951, DAILY WORKER, (official organ of the Communist Party) recognizing a kindred spirit in Henry Luce, publisher of TIME, LIFE and FORTUNE, lavishly praised him for his attacks on an anti-Communist.
