STATEMENT BY SENATOR CLIFFORD P. CASE
ON THE BOMBING OF NORTH VIET NAM

The continuation of the bombing of North Viet Nam, including the unprecedented use of our strategic B-52 bombers against urban targets, is without justification.

Should the bombardment continue, the Congress, when it reconvenes, will have an obligation to bring about a complete termination of American involvement, if necessary by cutting off funds for the war by a date certain.

In the past, we have come close to passing such legislation. This time, surely, the American public will demand that this be done.
